

2012 USA Wrestling Utah Tournament Standards

Pre-season

1. Complete and return Tournament Contract by Sept. 15th 2011 to USA Wrestling Utah Executive Director
2. Charter your club before Sept. 15th 2011

Pre-event

1. Provide number of full size mats (minimum of 6 full size mats)
2. Submit tournament flier to USA Wrestling Utah by Feb. 1st 2012
 - a. Tournament flier must include:
 - i. Tournament contact
 - ii. Registration closes at 4:30pm on Thursday
 - iii. Must have USA Card (can purchase at <http://www.usawmembership.com/>)
 - iv. Red and Blue singlet for freestyle & Greco-Roman, head gear for all fly-schoolboy, wrestling shoes with laces taped or lace guard
 - v. Must Pre-register at trackwrestling.com
 - vi. Venue Address
 - vii. Weigh-ins – Will be conducted by Chartered Clubs at their club sites on Thursday (see wrestleutah.com for list of all chartered clubs and contact numbers)
 - viii. Schedule of Events
 - Friday – Greco
 - 5:30pm-5:45pm – Coaches/Officials Meeting
 - 6:00pm-7:30pm – Greco – Fly, Bantam, Intermediate & Schoolboy
 - 7:30pm-Conclusion – Greco – Novice, Cadet, Junior & Open
 - Saturday
 - 8:00am-8:15am – Coaches/Officials Meeting
 - 8:30am-11:00am – Freestyle/Folkstyle – Fly Bantam, Intermediate & Schoolboy
 - 11:00am-Conclusion – Freestyle/Folkstyle – Novice, Cadet, Junior & Open
 - b. Order medals for at least 1st – 3rd place for each weight class
 - c. Print 2 sets of brackets the day of or night before event, one for the wall and one for the tables.

Registration

1. No walk up registrations will be allowed. All registrations will be made via [trackwrestling](http://trackwrestling.com).
2. No bracket changes will be allowed after brackets are made Thursday night, except in cases of significant number of forfeits or for wrestlers registered but not appearing on the bracket, or approval from USA Wrestling Utah.
3. Late registrations will be taken between 4:30pm and 9:00pm on Thursday with a \$20 late fee per wrestler attached to the entry fee.

Weigh-in

- a. Weigh-ins will be conducted by chartered clubs only.
- b. Host club must hold open weigh-ins at their site and have times and location published on flier.
- c. Club Presidents will receive a username and password Wednesday via the email listed as the contact email for the club and must enter weights no later than Thursday at 9pm and no earlier than Thursday at 5:30pm

Brackets

- a. Brackets will be round robin format and will be made by the USA Wrestling Utah Thursday night after all weights have been entered.
- b. Once brackets are made by USA Wrestling Utah staff the tournament host will need to print 2 sets of brackets, one to be posted on the wall and one for the tables.

Event

1. Weights will be assigned to one mat for the whole tournament and can be moved if needed to help the tournament run efficiently.

Results

- a. All bout results must be entered into Trackwrestling within 48 hours of the tournament for tournament host to receive total payment.

Other things that you as a club must provide:

- Entry of results – can be done after tournament but must be done within 48 hours of completion of tournament. Failure to enter data will be a \$100 penalty per style.
- Create a flyer and a name – flier must be given to state for approval
- Medals or awards
- Fill out all the USA Wrestling Tournament paperwork
- Mats – rolling them out and setting them up safely, and taping them off
- Coaching chairs optional
- Official's tables for scoring
- Pens, pencils and markers for each mat area
- Stop watches for each mat area
- Towels for each area
- Table help refreshments once per day
- Runners if needed
- Paper towels, blood equipment, disinfectant for each area
- Garbage cans for each area, also near concessions and in halls
- Mopping and clean up ready
- Medical professional and/or EMT
- Internet access
- An onsite weigh-in Thursday night
- Pairing volunteers to help post brackets
- An intercom system
- Concessions stand
- Optional apparel and gear sales
- Clean and stocked restrooms
- Roping off the mats if possible
- A table for the State
- Ice and ice bags for injured wrestlers
- Head Club Pairer
- Printers
- Computers
- Printing paper
- Provide room/space for coaching/officials meeting
- Provide at least 6 full size mats (we suggest 8)
- Provide state with mat layout one week prior to tournament with at least 12 wrestling spaces

- \$50 comes out for pairing, \$50 for Head Official, \$25 per table help per day, and \$60 for event sanction
- The host club gets \$7 from every entry

State provides:

- Registration including payment etc.
- Setting up the tournament online
- Promotion on the website / emails
- Collecting money and late fees
- Official's shirts
- Coaches/Officials Meeting
- Head Official
- Head Pairer
- Club assignments to run mats
- Sanction the event online or by mail
- Providing a bout numbering system
- Calculate money for club rebates for table help
- Calculate money for Head Official and Head Pairer
- Official's wrist bands and whistles
- Pairing tournament
- Responsible to pay all trackwrestling fees
- Responsible to pay all credit card transaction fees

****You will need to print 2 sets of brackets at least one hour before tournament starts. One for the wall and one for the tables.**

State tournaments only: State provides scoring paddles, medals and other awards. Host should consider opening and closing ceremonies. State provides two more data entry pairing help and the club also will provide two helpers for data entry at state.
